

MAKEUP INSTRUCTIONS SNOW QUEEN

Dear parents and students

As snow Queen draws closer I am writing to let you know what is happening with the makeup for this year's performance. A few new developments have been added since last year.

1) Parents of students in **preschool, preprimary, primary, grade 2** classes are expected to drop their child off with the following makeup applied:

✚ **Foundation - in a shade appropriate to child's skin tone**

✚ **Lipstick - a cherry red lipstick**

✚ **Mascara - black waterproof is preferable**



**The face paint being used for your children is Aloe Vera, cocoa butter, and chamomile based and is suited to very sensitive skin types.

All other dancers are expected to arrive at the theatre with a clean moisturised face as their make up will be applied at the theatre wither by themselves or by a volunteer. Parents of children in grade **1**, grade **3**, grade **4**, grade **6** classes are expected to provide the following for their children:

✚ **An old face cloth** to remove the stage makeup (preferably something you can throw in the garbage after as the makeup will stain it.)

✚ **A makeup remover product** - the BEST way to remove stage makeup is with cold cream. If you do not want to buy cold cream the other two ways to easily remove the makeup is dish soap or baby oil.

✚ **Grade 6 students will be expected to apply their own makeup.** A tutorial on how to apply the makeup will be offered in the next few weeks.

2) Due to hygienic reasons and the onset of germs/flu/H1N1 we have decided to buy more brushes, sponges, and q-tips to diminish the chance of sharing germs and makeup between students. If you would like to bring your own sponges/brushes/q-tips for applying makeup this is also fine.
